The **Office for Science and Technology** of the Embassy of France in the United States partners with **Inserm** to organize a seminar on “**Epigenetics Metabolism & Nutrition**” dedicated to French and US Ph.D. students. The objective is to enhance scientific exchanges between young researchers, increase mutual awareness of laboratories of excellence in this field and to possibly trigger collaborations between US and French laboratories. The seminar will be followed by 3 days of visits to state-of-the-art French laboratories and companies working on the topic "Epigenetics Metabolism & Nutrition".

The 2-day seminar will take place at the **Gustave Roussy Institute**, in **Villejuif, France**. **English will be the working language**. The American and French Ph.D. students will have the opportunity to present their work in a relaxed environment and to discuss their results freely. **Four lectures** will also be given by **French experts** to present different fundamental aspects of the field. Up to 12 US Ph.D. students will be able to participate in this post-graduate seminar and will be selected according to their level of excellence.
