

## For whom?

This event is designed for both American and French students from 5th to 10th grade and their teachers. As most of the scientists present will be French speakers, **French-speaking audiences are welcome!**

Classes will be divided into groups of 10 to 13 students, in order to visit each booth in an orderly fashion .

## For how long?

Up to 20 booths will be available, with hands-on activities of around 15 minutes each. We will organize your schedule so that every group of students will attend at least 6 booths (for a total duration of 2 to 2½ hours per group).

Our advice: plan to spend **3 hours** on site, to allow a pleasant visit and a break in the morning/afternoon for your students!
